The following course should be added to the list of courses with partial Middle Eastern content:

HIST 354-3 Imperialism and Political Modernization in Asia. A comparative discussion of the Western intervention in the political and administrative life of selected traditional societies of Asia over the past two centuries, and of the resulting confrontation of the 'old' and the 'new' in the nationalist reactions in the politics of modernization that became the concomitant of independence.

Rationale: This course has over $50 \%$ Middle Eastern content and is normally taught by Dr. J. Spagnolo, an Associated Faculty of the AME. Program. It was simply overlooked in the last calendar's revision.

The Department of Geography wishes to make the following changes in its requirements for the 1983/84 Calendar.

Lower Division Course Requirements:
delete: Geog 251-3 "Methods in Spatial Analysis". The reason for the change is that the subject of this course is already covered in Math 101.
add: Math 102-3 as an alternative to Math 101-3. This change will give the student a choice between the two "Introduction to Statistics" courses. The requirement would read Math 101-3 or Math 102-3.

Upper Division Course Requirements:
The changes requested for the upper division involve adding a number of Geography courses as options in the non-science sections. The reason for the additions is to give students a wider choice of Geography courses so that an ancillary interest might be developed.

Please note that Geography 311 "Hydrology" and Geography 411 "Models in Hydrometeorology" are new courses that are before the Faculty of Arts Curriculum Committee for approval.
