

FROM: PSYC 444-5 Psychopathology

TO: PSYC 444-5 Psychopathology (with ^{prior} approval of Coordinator)

Rationale: The subject matter in PSYC 444 varies according to the interest and expertise of the instructor - it is essentially a special topic course. The credit for this course should be applicable to DGT requirements only when the subject matter relates to aging or the aged.

The Curriculum Committee of the Gerontology Diploma Program has approved the following change in pre-requisite for GERO 410-3 (Special Topics in Gerontology):

FROM: GERO 300

TO: 60 semester hours credit. GERO 300 recommended.

Rationale: It is considered desirable that the prerequisites for GERO 410 be the same as for GERO 401. Both courses are optional courses within the Program; it is considered desirable that students taking GERO 410 should have completed at least 60 semester hours credit; completion of GERO 300, although desirable, is not strictly necessary as preparation for GERO 410.


REVISED CALENDAR ENTRY:
