

Subject Calendar Changes

Date October 6, 1980

As this is the time to make changes in calendar entries, I propose the following changes:

- a) Education 819-5. Change title from

Studies in Teacher-Student Interaction and Curriculum Development

to

Studies in Teacher-Student Interaction

Rationale-This change recognizes current practices of course instructors

-The T/S Interaction literature has developed considerably and warrants separate treatment

-The establishment of Educ. 930, together with Educ. 816, makes it possible to cover the "Curriculum Development" concerns.

- b) Education 837-5. Change title from

Advanced Seminar in Education and Social Philosophy and Sociological Theory

to

Seminar in Education and Social Theory

Rationale-As it is the first seminar "advanced" is unnecessary and misleading.

-The current title is a stylistic atrocity.

- c) Education 823-5. Change title from


Recent Developments in Curriculum and Instruction in an Individual Teaching Specialty

to

Curriculum and Instruction in an Individual Teaching Specialty

Rationale-This change is to remove linguistic redundancy and bring title in line with the way the course is taught.

-In addition delete recent in the body of the course description.
