ADD: Seminars and Special Topics Courses

A student may not enrol in a Philosophy seminar or selected topics course which deals with a general topic the student has studied in another Philosophy seminar or special topics course.

Students may not take this course for further credit if the topic is one which they have studied in PHIL 207, 231, 331, 435, 437, 438, 439, 440, 441, 442, 467, or 468.

p. 184 PHIL 435-5

Students may not take this course for further credit if the topic is one which they have studied in PHIL 207, 231, 331, 360, 437, 438, 439, 440, 441, 467, or 468.

p. 185 PHIL 467-5

Students may not take this course for further credit if the topic is one they have studied in PHIL 207, 231, 331, 360, 435, 437, 438, 439, 440, 441, 442, or 468.

p. 185 PHIL 468-5

Students may not take this course for further credit if the topic is one they have studied in PHIL 207, 231, 331, 360, 435, 437, 438, 439, 440, 441, 442, or 467.
