Senate referred to individual Faculties the question of credit for the Education 404 program.

In the Faculty of Science, the Undergraduate Curriculum Committee, at its meeting of March 17th, recommended as follows:

THAT those courses which would normally fulfill the requirement for the B.Sc. degree, and which are taken as part of Education 404, should be given credit towards the B.Sc. degree.

This recommendation was brought to the Faculty of Science at its meeting of April 14th. I am happy to report that the Faculty moved the adoption of the report of the Undergraduate Curriculum Committee, and this action by the Faculty should be so indicated to Senate.
