

**Subject:** International Undergraduate Students



---

Three years ago, Senate approved a motion from SCEMP to set a target for international students at 10% of SFU's funded undergraduate FTE target for a three year period. This is now coming back to Senate with a recommendation that the target be carried over for an additional five years – 2006/7 to 2010/11. This target was advanced in SFU's Strategic Plan for Internationalization.

Action undertaken by the Senate Committee on Enrolment Management and Planning gives rise to the following motion.

**Motion**

*international student enrolment be*

“That Senate approve and recommend to the Board of Governors that SFU adopt the long term objective that 10% of its funded undergraduate student complement ~~be international students~~. The objective excludes exchange students and will be reviewed after five years.”
