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Change in Prerequisites

PHIL. 467-5 Seminar II

Delete: "Normally students registering in Phil. 467, will be expected to have completed Phil. 360.

PHIL. 468-5 Seminar III

Delete: "Normally students registering in Phil 468, will be expected to have completed Phil. 467.

Rationale

It was the intention of the Department that it's three upper division seminars - PHIL 360, 467, 468 - be taken in a sequence. But scheduling constraints and pedagogical considerations equally show this to be an ill-founded idea.
