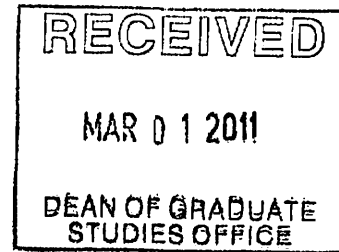

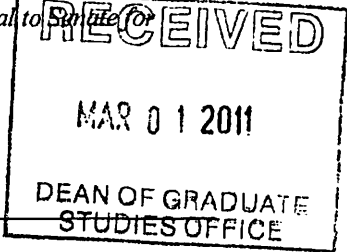
Please find attached a Graduate Course Minor Change form and a rationale for EDUC 873-4. We are requesting a title and description change.
