Course Description:

Serious consideration will be given to the nature and status of moral judgments; this analysis will be used to investigate the possibilities of moral education in schools and to confront the several value dimensions of school counselling.

Detailed Course Outlines will be available in mid-December.

Requirements: (1) short review of a book on 20th C. Ethics.
(2) one class presentation.

(3) one major research paper on a topic of the student's choosing.
