2. be able to develop programmes in art for chosen groups of students

OUTLINE OF TOPICS:

Aims of art education, BC curriculum, making and appreciating art, art history, the gallery visit, hands-on review of media, computer art, integration, multicultural art activities, developing and teaching art lessons, evaluation.

COURSE REQUIREMENTS:

| 2. Critique of artwork following a gallery visit | 30% |
| 3. Development of an art unit for a chosen group | 30% |
