

Temporarily Withdrawn Courses- BUS 451 Project in International Marketing

The Beedie School of Business' Undergraduate Curriculum Committee has voted to move Business 451 – Project in International Marketing from Active to Temporarily Withdrawn, in accordance with the options presented through Senate. This course is expressly required for the special exchange program the Beedie School of Business has with the BI Norwegian Business School. The program ran each year. However, as of fall 2011, BI Norwegian Business School has not been able to attract the minimum number of student participants from its school and so the program has temporarily suspended. In turn, the Beedie School of Business would like to temporarily withdraw BUS 451 while the program is reviewed.
