# Name of Faculty and academic unit: Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences, The Labour Studies Program Current name of program: Labour Studies Certificate Proposed program name change: Labour Studies Certificate in Workplace Rights Rationale for change: The current certificate program is largely dormant. These changes provide a focus for the certificate, making it easier to promote to students, and differentiates it more substantially from the Minor. It helps direct students who might not Minor in Labour Studies to our applied and experiential courses, including on Labour Law and Collective Bargaining. Effective term and year: Fall 2019 The following credential(s) will be affected by this change: Certificate in Labour Studies

The certificate in Labour Studies Certificate in Workplace Rights offers an introduction to students a grounding in labour rights and the regulation of work.
