# **Student Election to Senate**

A call for nominations was sent to all undergraduate and graduate students on January 22, 2019 for seventeen student positions on Senate for term of office from June 1, 2019 to May 31, 2020.

Eleven nominations were received: two graduate students and nine undergraduate students.

The election rules state that there shall be at least one student elected from each faculty and at least three undergraduate and three graduate students among the total number of students elected. In accordance with the requirements, the following candidates were elected by acclamation:

# **Student Election to Board of Governors**
