RE:	Revision to Academic Dates 2020/2021		

At its meeting of November 20, 2020, the Calendar Committee reviewed the attached request for revision of the previously approved schedule for spring 2021 and summer 2021.

The Calendar Committee approves and recommends to Senate the following:

Motion 1:

“That Senate approve that the first day of classes for the Spring 2021 term be revised from Tuesday, January 5 to Monday, January 11 and that the first day of classes for the Summer 2021 term be revised from Monday, May 10 to Monday, May 17.”

Motion 2:

“That Senate approve the revised Spring 2021 calendar.”

Motion 3:

“That Senate approve that the number of teaching days in Summer 2021 term be reduced from 63 days to 61 days.”

Motion 4:

“That Senate approve the revised Summer 2021 calendar.”

Spring 2021 and Summer 2021 - Delayed Start of Classes

Motions:

Motion 1: Approve and recommend to Senate that the first day of classes for the Spring 2021 term be revised from Tuesday, January 5 to Monday, January 11 and that the first day of classes for the Summer 2021 term be revised from Monday, May 10 to Monday, May 17.

Motion 2: Approve and recommend to Senate the revised Spring 2021 calendar.

Motion 3: Approve and recommend to Senate that teaching days in Summer 2021 term are reduced from 63 days to 61 days.

Motion 4: Approve and recommend to Senate the revised Summer 2021 calendar.

Overview and Background

Due to the impact of COVID-19 on teaching and learning, instructors and students have experienced unprecedented challenges. With the shift to remote learning, instructors have been required to fully pivot how they teach. This includes, incorporating new technology, adapting curriculum, teaching, and assessment practices, and managing online classroom dynamics. As a result, it is important that instructors have adequate time to prepare for their courses to ensure the quality of education at SFU remains strong.

In addition, due to the late start of the Fall 2020 term, end-of-term administrative processes have been pushed back to late December. Following the release of Fall term grades and academic standing, students will have little lead time to seek advising, change classes, etc. in advance of the start of the Spring term.

Decision

To address the above concerns, it is recommended that the first day of classes for Spring 2021 be moved from Tuesday, January 5 to Monday, January 11 and Summer 2021 classes start on Monday, May 17 instead of Monday, May 10. This will provide for an additional four business days at the start of the Spring term for administrative process and supports, such as academic advising, before classes begin. In order to accommodate this shift, the Spring term exam period will be shortened from 14 to 12 days, which is not an issue given the implementation of new exam software in the Registrar’s Office. This shift results in only a one-day loss for staff to process final grade information.

By delaying the first day of classes for Summer 2021, this again allows instructors adequate time to prepare for Summer term instruction. To accommodate the later start date of May 17 and provide an adequate break and preparation time for the Fall 2021 term, we also recommend reducing the number of teaching days during the Summer term from 63 to 61. This year, UBC has 61 teaching days in the first term of their winter session and will have 62 in the second term. UVIC has 59 teaching days in the first term of their winter session and will have 59 teaching days in the second term. It is, therefore, not uncommon for post-secondary institutions to vary teaching days throughout the year and have less than 63, as is the current standard at SFU.
