Units 2 Course Subject/Number BUS 730 Effective Term and Year Fall 2025 Course Title Indigenous Business Environments in Community Rationale for Change: BUS 730 is designed to complement BUS 741 by providing the opportunity to engage in dialogue with community leaders through visiting Indigenous communities, and is a key component to Beedie's commitment to reconciliation. Reducing the units from 2 to 0 removes the tuition fee, supplemental fee, and grading requirements from this experiential component that could act as barriers if the course had elective status. Beedie grad programs is prepared to cover costs associated with BUS 730 to increase flexibility on when and where the experience is offered, allowing for a deepening of relationships with Indigenous communities, leaders, and partners across BC, strengthening collaborative efforts to TRC's Calls to Action and SFU's committments to indigenization and reconciliation.
