SUBJECT: NOTICE OF MOTION GRADUATE STUDENT REPRESENTATION ON SENATE

DATE: March 31, 2009

As a result of the Faculty restructuring, there are now 16 student senator positions, and I would like Senate to consider amending its rules to permit a higher minimum number of graduate and undergraduate student Senators.

Currently the Election Rules contained in the Rules of Senate state:

C. ELECTION RULES E. Students; Student Association

4. There shall be at least one graduate student and one undergraduate student among the total number of students elected to Senate under Part 7, Section 35(2)(h) of the University Act.

I recommend that Senate approve amendments to section C. E. 4. to increase the minimum number for graduate and undergraduate students to three of each. This would take effect next year for the students taking office in June 2010.
