Targets for 2000/01

Academic Planning

At the March meeting of Senate motions were approved to admit 4.987 new students to Faculties in 2000/01 in order to meet our provincial undergraduate FTE target.

On April 20th the provincial government informed us that they will fully fund an additional 230 FTE undergraduates in 2000/01 with the proviso that 94 of these are to be in "Hi-Tech" program areas.

Given the change in FTE target, the Senate Committee on Enrollment Management and Planning (SCEMP) met on April 26th and approved a proposal to admit 300 additional new students in 2000-3 and 100 additional new students in 2001-1. Since it was too late in the admission cycle to effect any changes for the summer semester, the intake target remain unchanged in 2000-2.

SCEMP also decided that the additional students should be allocated by Basis-of Admission and by Faculty in proportion to the targets already approved by Senate in the two semesters.
