This is a combined report from the University Board on Student Discipline (UBSD) and the Senate Committee on Disciplinary Appeals (SCODA) covering the period September 1, 1999 to August 31, 2000. A summary of the cases heard by UBSD and SCODA is attached for the information of Senate.

University Board on Student Discipline

The University Board on Student Discipline dealt with one case involving an allegation of academic dishonesty in the period covered by the report. The Board determined that the alleged offence had taken place and recommended penalty to the President.

Two further appeals submitted by students against departmental findings of academic dishonesty were abandoned by the students prior to formal hearing.
