

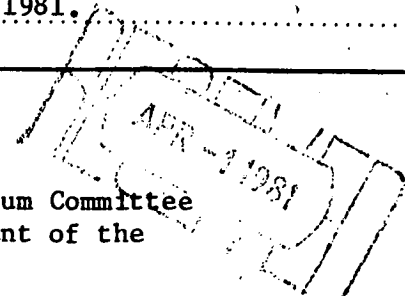



It is to request that the FIDS Undergraduate Curriculum Committee approve the following changes in the degree requirement of the computing major program.

- P. 321 (i) Replace "MATH 104-3 Elementary Computational Methods" with "MATH 216-3 Introduction to Computational Methods"
- (ii) Insert "MATH 316-3 may be used to satisfy the requirements of MATH 216-3"
- P. 322 Under the heading of Upper Divisions Course Requirements insert "it is advised that" before "this course normally should...."
- P. 323 (i) Table II - Replace "any course" with CMPT 305

These changes reflect the current practice of the department.
