SCIENCE 010

"Dr. Barlow reported that Science 010 had generally been considered well worthwhile and that a questionnaire, sent to the students enrolled in the course, indicated that the students were overwhelmingly in favour of the course being offered again. Since Senate approval had been obtained for a once only offering of this course, it was agreed that the necessary documentation be prepared for submission to Faculty and Senate to have the course continued."
