Proposed Motion for the Senate Meeting of September 8, 1969.

Whereas Senate, as the highest academic body within the University, has a deep and continuing interest in encouraging the devotion of faculty members to teaching and also in maintaining the original goal of Simon Fraser University as a university emphasizing teaching excellence,

Resolved

That Senate commends Professor John Leggett of the P.S.A. Department for teaching during the Summer Semester of 1969 without pay;

And, that Senate recommends to the Board of Governors, in the interests of the University, that the Board consider awarding Professor Leggett a token honorarium in recognition of his extraordinary services.
