**Revision of Admission Requirements for Fall 2011 online calendar.**

**Effective: Fall 2011**

**Summary of Changes**

- 1) The Undergraduate Department would like to add three World Literature 'W' courses to our Lower Division Requirement of English/Philosophy courses. These courses are WL 101W, WL 103W, and WL 104W.**

**Rationale**

To provide more range of W courses for admission for internal and external students transferring to SFU Business, especially at the Surrey campus where Engl/Phil courses are limited.

- 2) The Undergraduate Department would also like to add Phil 001 back to the Business/Computing Science Joint Major.**

**Rationale**

Phil 001 was removed from the list as an editorial mistake when Phil 100 and 120 were added back in 2005/2006. Phil 001 is not a W course; however adding Phil 001 is consistent with our other Joint Major and Major programs.

**Calendar Change**

Effective: **Fall 2011** online Calendar. The calendar changes are to be added to all Business programs (major, honours and joint majors/honours, and second degree) that require lower division requirements of 2 or 1 English/Philosophy. This change does not affect the Business Minor or SIAT/Bus Joint Major programs.
