MULTICULTURAL AND ANTI-RACIST EDUCATION
C100**

This course focuses on developing approaches for multicultural and anti-racist teaching. Topics include diversity of race, language, and culture among learners; the operation of racism, prejudice, and discrimination in classrooms and schools; approaches to counteract and prevent negative classroom and school dynamics (e.g. cooperative learning, culturally appropriate assessment, and community involvement); bias in curriculum resources; and entry points in selected curriculum areas (e.g. language arts, social studies, art, music) integrating approaches that employ a range of multicultural and anti-racist resources.

PREREQUISITES: 401/402. Students who have received credit for EDUC 382: Diversity in Educational Theories, Policies, Practices cannot take EDUC 441 for further credit.
