

EDUCATION 468-4 RECENT ADVANCES IN THE TEACHING OF ENGLISH AS A SECOND LANGUAGE

This course focusses on preparing ESL learners for academic success. Topics covered include: 1) teaching the humanities registers of English, 2) teaching the math and science registers of English, 3) teaching talk for participation in cooperative learning groups, 4) teaching cognitive self-instruction strategies to ESL learners, and 5) teaching ESL learners how to learn on their own.
