I. Proposed Motion for SCUS:

That the Senate Committee on Undergraduate Studies approve, under delegated authority, the Student Recruitment and Admissions office to have designated authority to add additional Ministry approved, language 11/12 courses to the SFU List A/B course lists.

II. Background:

The BC Ministry of Education recently changed the secondary school curriculum, which resulted in new courses which students may use for admission to SFU for Fall 2020 onwards. As there are many languages spoken around the world and the province, the Ministry sometimes adds additional courses to their approved lists during their school year. For example, there are many Indigenous languages of British Columbia for which curriculum has been developed and Ministry approved. SFU would like to recognize all Ministry approved language 11/12 courses for admission.

I. For Information:

The International Baccalaureate program recently changed their mathematics curriculum, resulting in the creation of four new courses. Student Recruitment & Admissions worked with the Math department to determine BC12 course equivalencies and transfer credit. New courses are as follows:

- Analysis and Approaches Higher Level (formerly Math Higher Level)
- Analysis and Approaches Standard Level (formerly Math Standard Level)
- Applications and Interpretation Higher Level (formerly Math Standard Level)
