I am pleased to submit the Annual Report of the Senate Policy Committee on Scholarships, Awards and Bursaries (SPCSAB) for the fiscal year 2018/2019.

Overview

SPCSAB is the committee charged by Senate with setting policy for the administration of student awards, scholarships, bursaries and other forms of financial aid at SFU. This is primarily for university-administered funding. Three other Senate committees, namely SUAAC (Senate Undergraduate Awards Adjudication Committee), SGAAC (Senate Graduate Awards Adjudication Committee) and SCUH (Senate Committee on University Honors) adjudicate financial awards to students, where adjudication is needed. Financial Aid and Awards is a unit within Student Services, which processes and administers undergraduate scholarships and awards (entrance, athletic, in-course), government student loans (Canadian and US) and needs-based bursary and work-study programs (for both undergraduate and graduate students).

SPCSAB is not responsible for administering budgets for scholarships, awards, work-study or bursary programs. We include for information, reports from both undergraduate (Appendix 1) and graduate studies (Appendix 2) indicating how funds were distributed. Policy decisions by SPCSAB in the 2018-19 period are detailed in Table 1.
