Music and Sound

Rationale for change:

As our program increasingly supports practices across the spectrum of music and sound art, this title more accurately communicates the full scape of what we do.

A degree in "music" now suggests a somewhat colonial perspective, implying a European tradition of conservatory training. While this remains a small part of what our program continues to represent, we have substantially expanded our foci to include a much greater diversity of perspectives and creative musical practices. While an all-encompassing term is still to be formed, the inclusion of "sound" as a defining characteristic points to the growing field of sound art, and one which has become a larger part of our program. A "sound" perspective, not limited to traditional notions of "music", is fundamental to the research-practices of three new faculty members, hired in the last five years.

The name change for our program is concurrent with an entire curricular change, which we are also submitting at this time.

Music and Sound Extended Minor

Those who wish a bachelor of arts (BA) general degree, by completing an extended minor, are directed to the music **and sound** extended minor. A balanced introduction to music composition, theory, history and performance **contemporary composition and creative music making** is supplied at the lower division, **with a less concentrated experience at the upper division**. A less concentrated upper division allows experience in a particular area. This minor may be used for teaching in the public and private school system.
