Updates to the language in the GGRs to clarify that a copy of the progress report should also be submitted to Graduate Studies. Programs that already use the Graduate Progress Report (GPR) in goSFU will not be impacted as this is already part of the process and Graduate Studies receives the goSFU GPRs. Programs using alternate tools or paper-based annual progress reports must make sure they are also providing a copy to Graduate Studies.
