During 1982-3 S.C.U.S. passed a new course proposal - Education 481-4 French Immersion and Programme-Cadre de Français. I did not seek a waiver of the regulation governing the delay before first offering the course. Since then the Faculty of Education has been chosen as the site for the 1983 Summer Institute for French Education funded by the Ministry of Education. This is a considerable honor, carrying, appropriately, a considerable budget to support it. Students will come from across Canada. A part of the program of the Institute will be two credit courses in the teaching of French. One of these should be Education 481. I request that I be granted a waiver of the requirement to delay offering a new course for two full semesters. I would like to schedule it in 1983-2.
