Regulations apply

For many years there have been special regulations authorizing a larger total than normal of transfer credit/course challenge hours toward the BGS degree provided the work is taken in British Columbia through one or more of Simon Fraser University, the University of British Columbia, the University of Victoria. These regulations were approved prior to the establishment in the province of the Open Learning Institute.

Approval has been given for some time by SUAB of transfer credit for certain OLI courses, but the ancillary regulations regarding the BGS degree have not been updated. The Faculty of Interdisciplinary Studies was requested some time ago by SCUS to give consideration to the regulations and now has brought forth its recommendation. The Senate Committee on Undergraduate Studies has concurred with the recommendation and the item is transmitted to SUAB.
