## APPENDIX 3

### CAN12 Admission Requirements

- Minimum five Grade 12 courses\*, including:
  - Minimum required List A courses
  - Additional List A or List B to meet the minimum of five
  - List B courses include:
    - Other courses/subject areas not appearing on minimum required lists
    - All approved Grade 11 courses
  - Approved equivalent IB and AP courses may also be used in place of List A and/or List B courses
  - English 12 (or equivalent) with a minimum, final grade of 70%
  - Math 11 or 12 (or equivalent) with a minimum, final grade of 60%
- All approved courses are used in the admission evaluation
  - Approved courses are from the following categories: English, Math, Science, Social Studies, Language Arts, Languages, Arts Education

\*Ontario students must present a minimum of six Grade 12 courses
