I would like to request that the following temporarily withdrawn History courses be reinstated:

HIST 805: The North American West

~~HIST 806: Themes in Canadian History~~

HIST 826: International Relations

HIST 879: Environmental History

HIST 883: Film and History

HIST 885: Law and Society

HIST 888: Indigenous Peoples

The overall rationale for keeping these courses is that our graduate students' research areas shift over time, and will continue to shift, so even if a course has not been offered in recent years it may need to stay in the calendar in order to recruit and serve prospective students. Also, we expect many of these courses to appeal to students enrolling in the new Graduate Certificate in History, and as indicated below we have plans in place for offering these courses in the near future.
