

Acting under delegated authority of Senate, the Senate Graduate Studies Committee approved revisions in the School of Resource and Environmental Management as follows:

Change of title: REM 631-5

Change under 'Required Courses': Drop "... and one of: REM 602-5, REM 641-5".

Change under 'Elective Courses':

From: "Students normally select 25 credit hours (usually five courses) to ..."

To: "Students normally select 30 credit hours (usually six courses) to ..."

Change 'Forestry' heading to 'Forest Ecology, Conversation and Management'.

Change under elective courses 'Forestry'

Add: REM 625-5 Risk Assessment and Decision Analysis for
Management of Natural Resources

REM 647-5 Parks and Outdoor Recreation Planning

Remove: REM 651-5 Project Evaluation

Prerequisite change: REM 613-5
