
Action undertaken by the Senate Committee on Graduate Studies at its meeting of November 14, 1983, gives rise to the following motion:-

The Faculty of Interdisciplinary Studies Graduate Curriculum Committee recommends the following change in course requirements for the M.Sc. program in Computing Science. The proposed change is to require all M.Sc. students to take CMPT 810-3, The Design and Analysis of Algorithms. Specifically, the calendar change would be made in the section:

Degree Requirements - M.Sc. program, 1. Course Work (p. 249). The first sentence in this section currently reads:

"The minimum course requirement for the Master's degree consists of 18 semester hours of graduate-level course credit, at least 15 of which must be in Computing Science."

It would be changed to read:

"The minimum course requirement for the Master's degree consists of 18 semester hours of graduate-level course credit including CMPT 810. At least 15 of these 18 semester hours must be in Computing Science."
