Thesis: The candidate will prepare a thesis proposal which will be circulated to faculty and resident graduate students, and will present this proposal for discussion at a Departmental colloquium.

Upon completion of the thesis, formal presentation will be made to the Examining Committee, and any other individuals, at a Departmental colloquium.

Time Required for Degree:

It is anticipated that the requirements for the degree normally can be completed in four (4) semesters.
