- p.108 GEOG 250-3 New Course for former Geog 151. Addition of prerequisite. See Appendix A.
- p.110 GEOG 351-3 Title Change: "Cartography II". Course was formerly entitled "Advanced Cartography".
- Prerequisite Change: From "Geography 151-3" to "Geography 250-3".
- Rationale:
To accommodate renumbering of GEOG 151 to GEOG 250. Also better description of continuation purpose of the course from the former 151-3 (now 250-3 Cartography I). See Appendix B.
- p.108 GEOG 263-3 Prerequisite change: Add "Prerequisite: 30 credit hours".
- p.110 GEOG 344-3 Title Change: "Geography of Modern Industrial Societies". Course was formerly entitled "Geography of Contemporary Industrial Societies". See Appendix C.
