Re. BIOLOGICAL SCIENCES COURSE CHANGES

At the time of the approval of the present calendar in Senate some last minute changes were requested by the Biological Sciences Department and incorporated. Senate, however, requested these changes to be submitted to the Faculty of Science for their approval. They have since been discussed in the Undergraduate Curriculum Committee of the Faculty of Science, and the Faculty of Science accepted the recommendations of its Undergraduate Curriculum Committee on the Biological Sciences course changes by unanimous vote as follows:

Biology 202 changed from "Human Genetics" to "Genetics"

Biology 402 changed from "Genetics" to Physiological Genetics"

The description of Biology 402 changed to "Detailed consideration of the structure and function of genetic elements"
