On October 14, 2010, the Faculty of Communication, Art and Technology Undergraduate Curriculum Committee approved the following curricular revisions passed by the School of Interactive Arts & Technology UCC on September 8, 2010:

- Change SIAT BA and BA Honours Requirements Upper Division Requirements > Additional Requirements:
 - Remove IAT 483-3 Special Topics in New Media Environments
 - Add IAT 380-3 Special Topics in Interactive Arts and Technology (Arts)
 - Add IAT 480-3 Special Topics in Interactive Arts and Technology
- Change SIAT BSc and BSc Honours Requirements Upper Division Requirements > Additional Requirements:
 - Remove IAT 484-3 Special Topics in Technology in Arts and Design
 - Add IAT 381-3 Special Topics in Interactive Arts and Technology (Science)
 - Add IAT 481-3 Special Topics in Interactive Arts and Technology (Science)

Rationale:

IAT 483 and 484 have never been offered and were intended to be a part of streams that were in SIAT between 2003 and 2007. IAT 483 and 484 have titles that reflect concentrations that were phased out in 2007. This was an



oversight in our last curriculum change in 2007 and needs to be corrected to reflect the current courses offered at SIAT. Conversely, IAT 380, 381, 480, and 481 are being used in our current curriculum and need to be recognized.

Notes:

- The rationale to having 2 courses count towards the B.A. degrees, and 2 that count towards the B.Sc. is that they are different degrees requiring different courses for graduation. As such, it is felt that having separate "Arts" and "Science" special topics courses is necessary for those pursuing our degrees.
- IAT 480 does not have (Arts) affixed to the end of it. This is the name of the course officially in the university calendar as approved by SCUS. We will be submitting a course change form to change the title of this course in Fall 2010, at which point the Calendar language will be automatically updated to reflect the new course title.
- These are listed as "Upper Division Requirements > Additional Requirements". This is the terminology used by the university calendar as viewed at <http://students.sfu.ca/calendar>. It is not intended to say these are required courses; rather, they are to be viewed as one of a list of options towards either the B.A. or B.Sc., as shown in the calendar.
- When we do offer special topics courses, they get a special topic coded by the Registrar's office. An example would be:

* IAT 380-3 Special Topics in Interactive Arts and Technology (Arts) – ST: Sound Design.

- There is a distinction between Arts courses and Science courses for special topics. This is intentional and is necessary because we must have differentiation between our B.A. and B.Sc. degrees.

On October 14, 2010, the Faculty of Communication, Art and Technology Undergraduate Curriculum Committee approved the following curricular revisions passed by the School of Interactive Arts and Technology UCC on January 13, 2010:

- Course Change Proposal: Change WKTM 100 to IAT 271
- Course Change Proposal: Change WKTM 200 to IAT 272
- Course Change Proposal: Change WKTM 300 to IAT 373
- Course Change Proposal: Change WKTM 400 to IAT 374
- New Course Proposal: IAT 375

These pertain to Co-operative Education courses in use exclusively by SIAT effective Fall 2010. Like all other SFU co-op programs, SIAT should use its own coding course codes for practicum coursework. The WKTM courses were created during the transition from TechBC due to the uncertainty around the future of the Surrey campus at the time and a lack of a permanent program in place. With SIAT having been established in 2003, these courses are due to be properly incorporated into the IAT curriculum.

These are being submitted as course change proposals for legacy reporting purposes to ensure as much continuity of data as possible for our co-operative education department. At one point, these codes were shared with Computing Science co-op at Surrey due to shared staff resources, but CMPT began using CMPT co-op course codes prior to Fall 2010. Note that with the small presence of CMPT at Surrey, the number of work terms completed by those


students was relatively minor. Nav Chima and Frances McLafferty in SIAT/CS Co-operative Education have verified that their preference would be to use Course Change as opposed to a New Course Proposal to ensure accurate statistics over the last 7 years.
